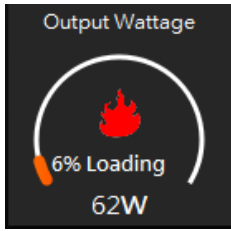

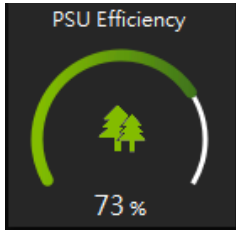
B. Current PSU Temperature (Celsius / Fahrenheit)



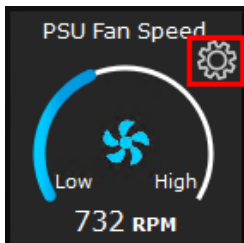

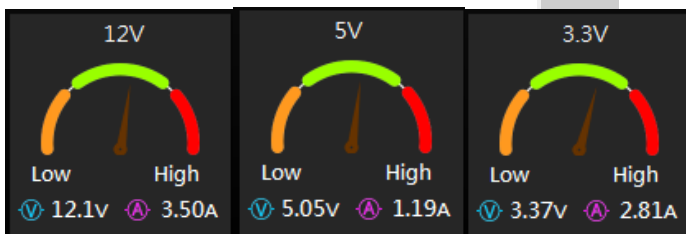

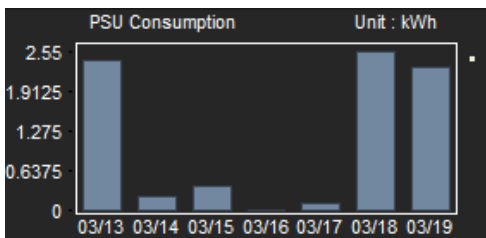

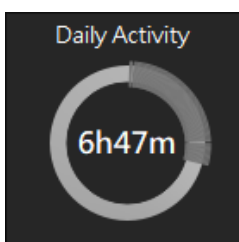

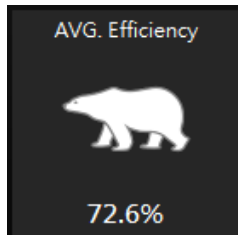

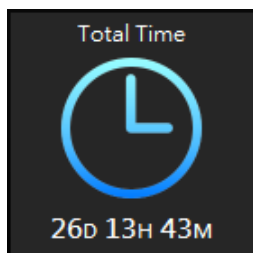

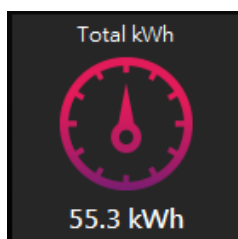

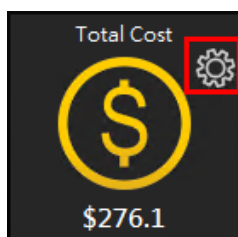

RGB Effects



A. Lighting effects :

1. **Flow** : The light flows through the set colors.
2. **RGB_Spectrum** : The lights change through the color gradients simultaneously.
3. **Radar** : The light spins creating a radar display effect on your fan (sole color only).
4. **Blink** : The light blinks on and off.
5. **Pulse** : The light pulses and shines at a certain speed.
6. **Wave** : The light rotates in a clockwise direction like a wave. (RGB only)
7. **Static** : Lights on without any effects.
8. **Temp.** : The light changes according to the temperature of the power supply.

9. **Movie** : Lighting changes with your movie audio. (Recommended for watching movies)

10. **Gaming** : Lighting changes with played audio. (Recommended for games)

11. **Party** : Lighting changes with audio input creating a party atmosphere.

12. **Cross** : Two lights cross in the opposite direction.

13. **Heartbeat** : The light pulses like a heartbeat.

14. **Scan** : The light imitates a scanner and shines back and forth.

15. **Swirl** : The light spins in a spiral, the Light swirls and spins.

16. **Raindrop** : The light imitates raindrops to light up and go off.

17. **Stack** : The light stacks slowly one by one.

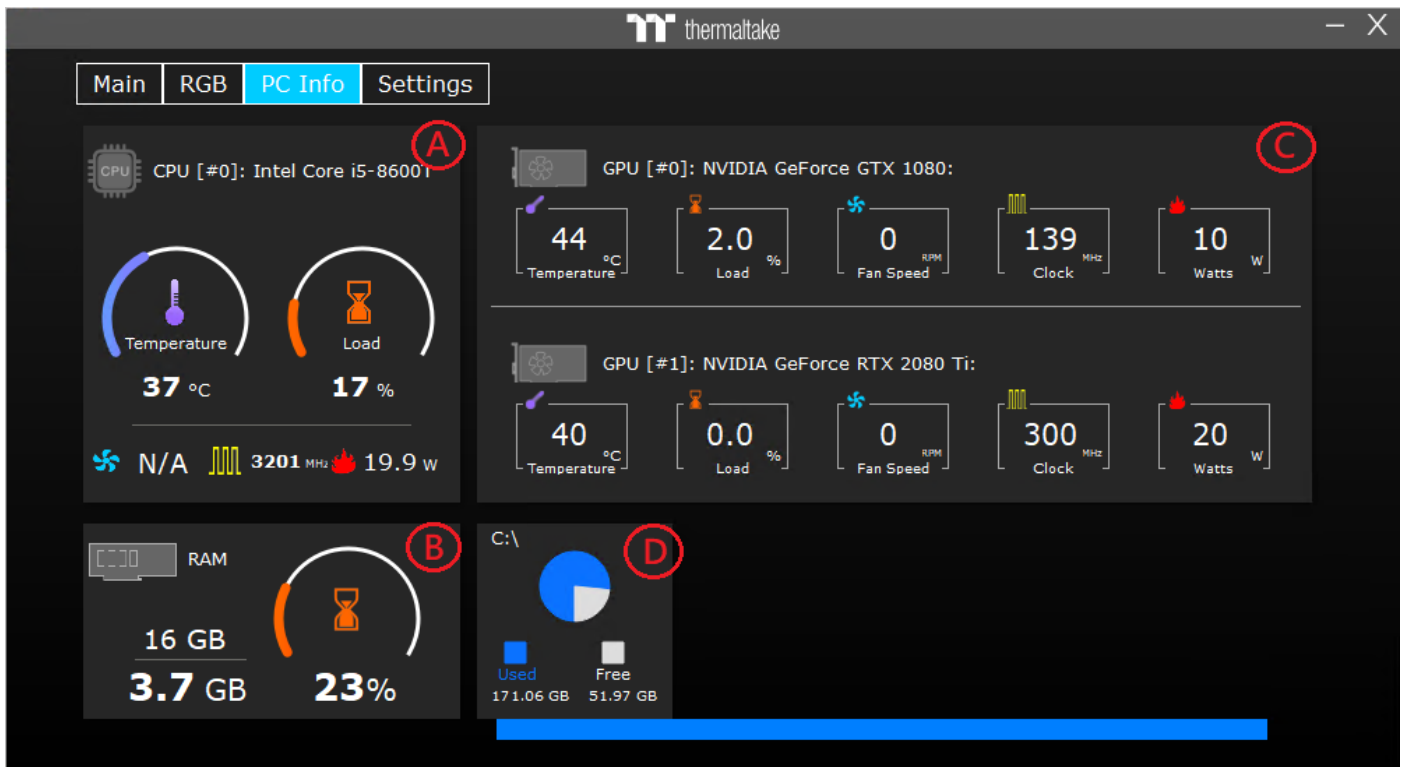

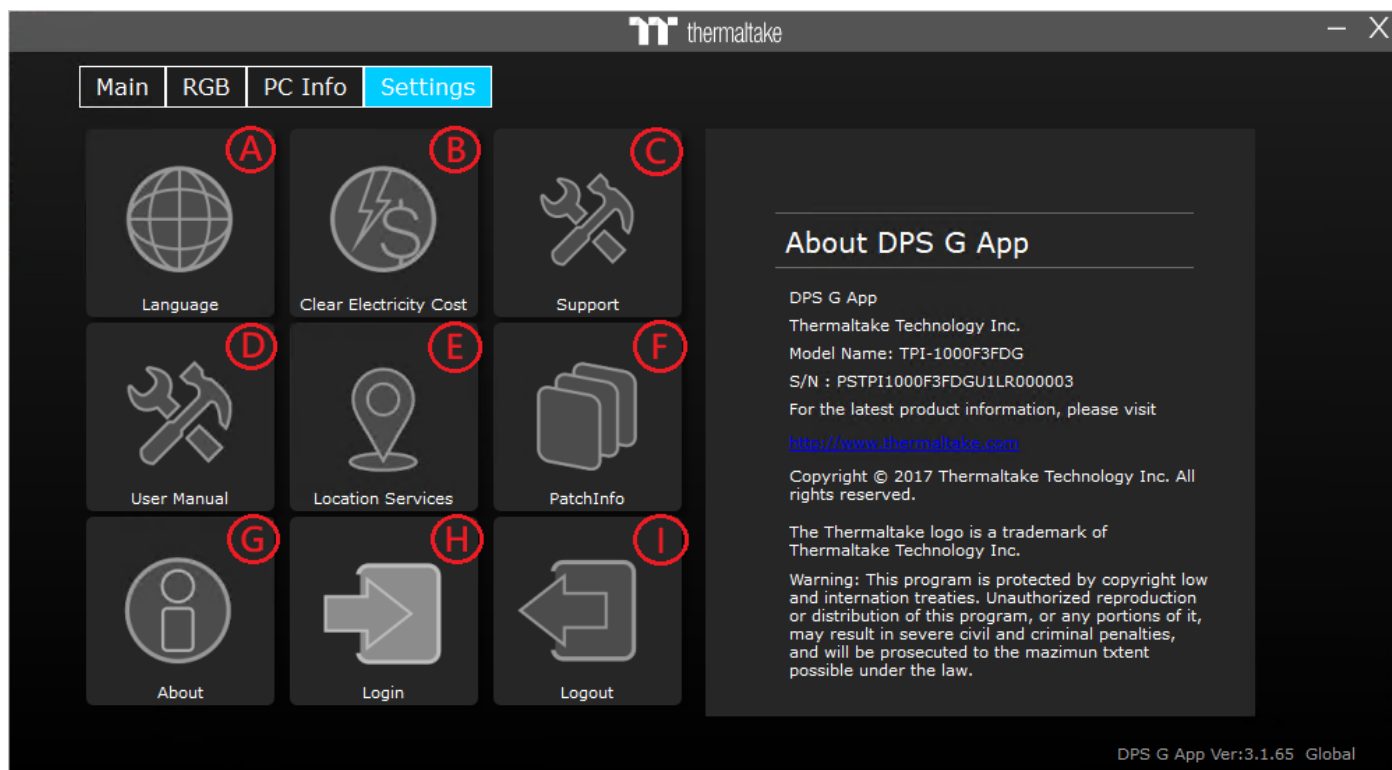

Q : No response when you login the account?

Q : Failed to launch the DPSG program or no response when you click it?

A : Please go to folder C:\user\your account\AppData\Roaming\Tt\, and delete the “DPS-G” folder then reopen the program.

Q : Clicked “Zero Fan” but the fan is still on?

A : The “Zero Fan” mode is consistent to the lowest wattage output, if the product’s power consumption is higher than the rated wattage, the fan will spin at the lowest fan speed.
